

Sedona Charter School COVID-19 EXPOSURE GUIDELINES

Understanding "Close Contact"

- 1) Being a household member or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected Covid-19 Case.
- **2)** Being within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected Covid-19 case for more than 15 minutes, even if wearing a non-medical face covering.
- 3) Having unprotected contact with the infected person's body fluids, for example, being coughed or sneezed on.

Quarantine Necessary if:

- 1) Not vaccinated or not having had positive laboratory results of Covid-19 in the last 3 months. Quarantine for 14 days from time of exposure. **OR**
- 2) Exposure without symptoms*-

If "close contact" shows no symptoms for 10 days, then the student may return to school. Student may shorten quarantine to 7 days by testing negative 5 days after exposure.

3) Exposure with symptoms*:
The "close contact" should be tested. If positive, then isolate for 10 days from when symptoms* first appeared and until no symptoms* are present for 48 hours. If negative, quarantine 14 days from time of 1st exposure.

No Quarantine Necessary if:

- 1) The "close contact" has been fully vaccinated and shows no symptoms* of Covid-19. Still get a test 3-5 days after exposure and mask indoors for 14 days following exposure or until negative tests.
- 2) "Close contact" has had Covid-19 within 3 previous months and has recovered and remains without Covid-19 symptoms*.

If there is an illness in your home

- 1) Please be cautious and keep siblings of ill students at home. Lets work together to keep our community safe.
- 2) Please have students with lingering symptoms* of illness for more than 10 days be cleared by a negative Covid-19 test or alternative diagnosis before returning to school.
